A persistent cough is more than an annoyance. It can seriously impact your quality of life and social interactions and may cause you to feel isolated or anxious.

This study centre is running a clinical research study to see how safe an investigational drug is and whether it works in people with refractory chronic cough (RCC), including unexplained chronic cough.

We need to enrol a wide variety of participants because RCC and investigational drugs may affect people differently based on their age, sex, gender, and race and/or ethnicity.

We are looking for adults who:

- are between 18 and 80 years of age
- have had a cough for at least 1 year that did not improve or only partially improved after medical evaluation and prescribed or over-the-counter treatments.

If you take part, you will be in the CALM-1 Study for about 1.5 years. You will visit the study centre at least 19 times and have 6 phone calls to check on your health.
